- Bus drop off: Please drop teams off in the southwest parking lot, near the Fitness Center and Swimming Pools. After dropping off, please park busses near the main entrance of the school off Shermer Road
- Entrance: All teams should enter through Door "O" near the Fitness Center and proceed directly to the Pool
- Check - in: All team members should be screened prior to arriving to the Glenbrook North Campus. It is the responsibility of each coach to monitor appropriate social distancing of their athletes. Upon arrival please submit team rosters including coaches to the home administrator. Please do not enter the building earlier than 30 minutes prior to game. time.
- Spectators: Only a limited number of home fans will be allowed to attend any athletic contests. Spectators must adhere to current ISBE and IDPH guidelines. No visiting team fans at this time.
- Restrooms: Are available near the main gym, main gym lobby and pool hallway
- Locker-room: Will be available after each game for changing purposes only. (showers are not available) Please come suited and ready to play.
- Masks: All coaches, officials and bench players must wear a mask while in the Glenbrook North building, players do not wear a mask while actively engaged in the game.
- Officials: Please enter the campus at Door "O" and check with the security personnel. All officials will be asked to complete a Covid questionnaire upon arrival.
- Warm-up: Warm-up water polo balls will be provided, all water polo balls will be sanitized before, during and after each game.
- Trainers: Certified Athletic Trainers will be available to treat any athletes that are injured during a contest.
- Water: Visiting teams must provide their own water.

- Team benches: Only 20 total players and coaches will be allowed on deck per school. Team will be Benches sanitized before and after every game. Teams will not switch benches/sides. Other team personnel must remain in the east balcony.
