

Maine East Athletic Spectator Guidelines and Procedures

Per the <u>IDPH Sports Safety Guidance</u> for Phase 4, Maine East Athletics allows spectators to attend home contests following these guidelines and procedures:

Spectator Guidelines

- Maximum of 50 spectators per contest in the Fieldhouse Main Gym and 50 spectators in the Maine East Pool.
- Limited to varsity and JV contests only.
- Must be immediate household members or guardians of participants.
- Two spectators allowed per varsity student-athlete and/or coach.
- May not arrive earlier than 20 minutes before the start of the contest.
- Must present a photo ID.
- Must answer "no" to all COVID screening questions.
- Must wear face coverings at all times in the building.
- Separated by a minimum of 30 feet from participants.
- Spectators are only permitted to sit with family members they came with.
- Please sit in assigned marked seats labeled with Yellow X.
- Spectators are not to interact with coaches or athletes before, during, or after the game.
- Upon the conclusion of the game, spectators are to exit the gym immediately. Fans will not be permitted to wait around for players.
- Not allowed to shout, sing or chant at any time while they are in the building.
- Concessions not available; **NO FOOD** or **SODA/SOFT DRINKS** allowed!
- No more than two persons allowed in the bathroom at a time.

Spectator Procedures

- Varsity head coach submits a "Pass List" of spectators (up to 2 per varsity athlete/coach; no more than 50 in Main Gym & 20 in Pool) to the Athletic Department 6 hours prior to the contest.
- Spectators must complete the Maine East Athletic Contest Visitor <u>FORM</u> within 12 hours prior to their arrival. An SQR code will be available at the entry for spectators to access the google form if needed. Anyone answering "yes" to any of the COVID screening questions will not be allowed into the building.
- Spectators must present their photo ID upon arrival.
- Maine East Athletic Department staff checks photo ID and confirms visitors are on the approved spectator "Pass List" list submitted by the head coach and has submitted the Maine East Athletic Contest Visitor FORM.
- Spectators will have their hands "stamped" upon entry into the building for the specific contest.
- Maine East event staff will monitor spectators to ensure they are following the social distance
 requirements, wearing their face covering, and are not shouting or singing. Spectators not following
 these rules will be given two warnings before being escorted from the contest and suspended from
 attending the next home contest.
- No more than two persons will be allowed in the restrooms at one time.
- Maine East event staff & the "AOD" or administrator on duty will clear the seating area of spectators after the contest and escort them to the exit.
