Welcome to the 2002 Hall of Fame and All-State Awards Banquet at the beautiful Chicago Athletic Association in downtown Chicago, Illinois.

Back in October, David Fry (Executive Director of the IHSA) mailed a letter to each member school in the state of Illinois asking if their school will enter a team if the association would hold a state series in water polo. In order to make this happen, a minimum of 65 boys and/or girls member schools would have to enter a team to play in the 2002 season. If one group got to 65, the other group would also be included. If you get the opportunity tonight, make sure to stop these individuals and thank them for all their hard work in getting us to this point. It is because of them that we can celebrate this event.

I would also like to thank all the players, coaches, officials and administrators who work to make our season a success year after year. A "tip of the hat" goes out to Perry Korbakis, head of the officials, for taking the time he does to bring in new officials and make the schedule work. Russ Curry once again kept accurate financial records for the league (Thanks Russ!).

I hope you enjoy this evening's event and please join us in celebrating our 1st of many IHSA State Series in Water Polo. It has been a pleasure serving as your Chairman for the last 12 years. I look forward to the future success of the association under its new leadership and to the growth of Illinois Water Polo.
