# HALL OF FAME BIOGRAPHY



## NANCY O'BRIEN KANE

---

As the fourth of five children of John and Eileen O'Brien, Nancy O'Brien-Kane grew up on the Southside playing numerous sports, including swimming, water polo, basketball, volleyball, soccer, cheerleading and softball. Nancy was invited to join the Lawn Aqua Swim Team at age 4, after Nancy snuck out of the baby pool while her Mom wasn't looking, and was caught jumping off the 3M diving board! Nancy swam competitively year-round for 15 years at numerous Southside pools. Luckily in seventh grade, Nancy found herself a member of the Ridge Park Water Rats. Under the direction of Mary Meyering O'Connor, Mary Kay O'Connell and Scott White, Nancy found a forever home in Ridge Park.

After being introduced to water polo by Scott White and Larry O'Connell, Nancy soon fell in love with the game of water polo. Under the strong direction of coaches like Scott White, Joanie and Larry O'Connell, Andy Barry, Pat Bauer, Dave Perry and Moose Mulcrone, Nancy found her forever favorite sport in water polo. Around this same time, Nancy was blessed to meet the most wonderful water polo family-the Billish clan! Dick and Nancy Billish graciously allowed Nancy to join their family on many wonderful, memorable out-of-state trips to play in Junior Olympics tournaments.

With the help of Nancy's mom, Eileen O'Brien, and Scott White, Nancy helped start the swimming and water polo programs at Mother McAuley High School. Nancy competed at McAuley from 1981-1984 in water polo and swimming, and qualified several years for state in individual swimming and relay events. Thanks to the Billish family, Nancy gained two years of international experience while playing on the U.S.A. Jr. Women's National Team from 1983-1984.

After graduating from Mother McAuley in 1984, Nancy attended the University of Notre Dame. Nancy competed on Notre Dame's Varsity Swimming Team from 1984-1988. Nancy was Captain of the Swimming Team in 1988 and earned two Notre Dame Monogram Awards. Nancy also was the first and only woman to play all four years on the Notre Dame Men's Club Water Polo Team. Nancy received her Bachelor of Arts degree in American Studies from the University of Notre Dame in 1988. While studying abroad as a Junior in London, England, Nancy trained with a Men's Water Polo Team, and during the summers she trained with Loyola University Men's Team. While studying abroad, Nancy also met the love of her life, Jim Kane, from Tyler, Texas. After Nancy graduated from Notre Dame, she attended Loyola University of Chicago School of Law and obtained her law degree in 1991. Nancy has been a practicing attorney for 31 years and has taught law on the undergraduate level.

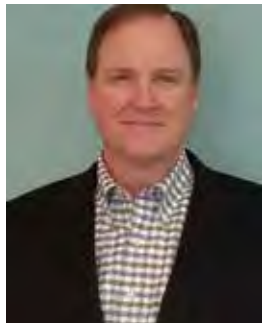
Nancy married her best friend, Jim Kane, in 1990, and Nancy gave birth to her three beloved children, Jimmy, Johnny and Nancy Kane. Not long after the births of their children, Nancy and her lifelong friend, Maura Tiernan, coached water polo at Mother McAuley High School from 2000-2003 with an overall record of 90-16. During their second year of coaching, Nancy and Maura guided McAuley's water polo team to an ISA State Tournament Runner-Up finish. After the IHSA sanctioned water polo as a sport, Nancy and Maura led McAuley's water polo team to the IHSA's first State Championship in 2002. In 2003, Nancy and Maura helped McAuley's water polo team earn its second IHSA State Championship. Nancy and Maura were named IHSA Coaches of the Year in both 2002 and 2003. Nancy refereed water polo for the IHSA for two years and also served on the IHSA Advisory Board for water polo. During the COVID epidemic from 2019-2021, Nancy and Maura returned to coach water polo at Mother McAuley High School. For 38 years, Nancy has coached various sports including swimming, water polo, soccer, basketball, volleyball, track and softball. Nancy hopes to continue to inspire young water polo players to join the sport and to reach for success in the sport she has loved her entire life and that has given Nancy her best friends and memories. # HALL OF FAME BIOGRAPHY

## BILL “SAL” VALENTINE

---

Bill (Sal) was born at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas and spent the first years of his life living in exotic locales such as Oahu and Ethiopia. It was in Hawaii, at the age of two, that he fell in love with the water as he spent hours on the beach with his mother and brother. In Ethiopia, at the age of five, his parents signed him up for swim lessons at the base pool. After Bill's family returned stateside, he swam for the prestigious Nashville Aquatics Club and joined the B.R. Ryall YMCA swim team in the early eighties when his family settled in Glen Ellyn, Illinois. At Glenbard West High School, Bill was a center-defender on the Hilltoppers' soccer team. After high school, he continued his swimming career at Eastern Illinois University while pursuing a degree in Physical Education. At this same time, he proudly served in the United States Navy Reserves as a Hospital Corpsman, spending much of his time stationed with the 4th Marine Division at Camp Pendleton, 29 Palms and Foster Avenue in Chicago.



Upon graduation from EIU (1988), Bill was employed as a teacher at Northwestern Memorial and Tilden high schools in Chicago, before finding his home at Naperville Central in the fall of 1992. Starting with a blank slate and a new facility, Bill became the Redhawks' Aquatics Director and Assistant Boys' Swim Coach. In the spring of 1993, he was asked by two student athletes if he could start a water polo club — until that time, the NCHS swimmers had been participating in club activities at Naperville North. In creating the club, Bill sought the advice of his oldest friend and former Purdue water polo club player Keith McCloy; as well as former EIU teammates Bill and Mike Wallace who had played the sport at Brother Rice.

### **Naperville Central Redhawks**

For the first seven years, the Redhawks competed as a club, sometimes coed, under the Illinois Water Polo Association. During this time, Sal did not keep track of his win-loss record as he was concentrating on developing his fledgling team. In the spring of 2000, the Redhawk water polo club became a varsity sport at Naperville Central, when it was classified as an emerging sport by the Illinois High School Association.

It did not take long for the Redhawks to emerge as a team to be reckoned with, earning their first IHSA tournament appearance in 2002 — a loss to eventual state champion Fenwick. Over the next 14 years, Sal's Redhawks competed in an additional eight IHSA tournaments racking up 3 second-place finishes and third-place finish. During this time he also was awarded his first Illinois Water Polo Coaches Association Coach of the Year award.

In 2016, the Redhawks' began their amazing run of three IHSA titles (2016, 2018 and 2019), an undefeated season and a third-place finish over four years. Sal was also named Coach of the Year three times during this run. He was also awarded IHSA and National Federation of High Schools Coach of the Year honors in 2010 and 2020; as well as being a finalist for National High School Athletic Coaches Association award in 2018 at their national conference in Sioux Falls, S.D.

Currently, Sal's IHSA record stands at 524-116-4. Several of his players have earned All-State and All-American honors. Many of his players continued playing the sport in college at varsity and at club levels. He is however, most proud, of the fact that several of his former players are now IHSA water polo coaches and/or officials; as well as the fine young men his players have turned into.

During many of the Redhawks' water polo games you will find Bill's wife Tamara, whom he met during the 1994 water polo season when she was a sports writer, and his son Liam, a college sophomore, in the stands cheering loudly. In his spare time, he enjoys golf, camping, fishing, hunting and kayaking.

# PHIL STELNICKI AWARD

## RICHARD NORMAN

---

Rich Norman began his water polo career playing grammar school water polo at Independence Park in 1961. After entering high school at Lane Tech, he began playing at Beilfuss Natatorium under coach Joseph A. Pecoraro. While in high school Rich also began playing at the Illinois Athletic Club which was coached by Ralph Erickson. At the IAC he played with several Olympians and Pan Am gold medalists. Upon graduating high school Rich attended Loyola University, playing on two teams that competed in AAU National Championships, the third place team in 1967 and the second place team in 1970 where he was selected as an All-American.



After graduating Loyola, Rich played and coached at Portage Park. In 1971-72 his team won the 15&U, 17&U, and Senior Men's water polo championships with basically the 15&U boys' team. In 1976 and 1978 his summer CPD teams won the North American Water Polo Championship, an international competition, at Portage Park. Rich also began taking teams to St. Louis and Des Moines Iowa for tournaments. During the early 1980's Rich began the practice of taking Chicago teams to compete in the national USWP Junior Olympics. He also coached at Loyola University from 1986-88 and attended development camps at the Air Force Academy. Rich was inducted into the Loyola University Athletic Hall of Fame for water polo in 1988.

Rich also simultaneously had a career as a water polo official. He refereed numerous ISA state championships, collegiate competitions, and summer tournaments. Rich refereed, with Dave Heck, the USWP national championship game in Indianapolis between NYAC and the Olympic Club in 1986. His referee mentors were Don Holbrook and Bill Frady. During several summers, Rich would coach teams and referee at the same tournaments.

Rich coached at the Latin School of Chicago as an assistant coach from 1988- 92. The Latin School finished 2nd to Fenwick in the ISA state championship. He then coached for four years at St. Patrick High School where his teams finished 13th, 3rd, 2nd, and 2nd. He was selected ISA water polo coach of the year in 1995 and 1996. In 1995, Rich was the assistant coach/manager of the North team at the Olympic Festival which won the gold medal. Rich then left coaching to return to graduate school. He refereed high school water polo including both girls' and boys' championship games in 1998. Rich returned to CPS in 1999 and worked with Isaac Marshall to get CPS involved in high school water polo. He started three programs at Mather, Northside College Prep, and Von Steuben that year, training at Northside. Rich then returned to The Latin School to coach girls water polo until 2005 when he became a high school principal at Nicholas Senn High School in Chicago.

Upon retiring in 2010 Rich coached one year at Latin and has refereed IHSA water polo from 2011-19. In 2021 Rich was a volunteer assistant coach at Lane Tech. He is in the inaugural ISA Water Polo Hall of Fame class in 1986 and the Loyola University Athletic Hall of Fame class of 1988. Rich retired from water polo after 60 years at the end of the 2021 high school season.

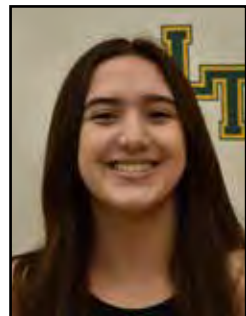
