WATER POLO

A Player's/Viewer's Guide

A demanding game, water polo combines the strategy and interaction of a team sport with the skill and endurance of an individual sport. A team consists of 6 *field* players and a *goalie*. Field players may use only one hand on the ball — the goalie may use both; field players may not use the pool bottom immediately prior to, or while, receiving, throwing or blocking the ball, although the *shallow-end goalie* may. (The goal has been enlarged to offset this advantage.) When outside the 4-meter line a goalie loses these "privileges", and in no case may he cross the center-line! The goalie may shoot, but not from off the bottom.

A high school game consists of four 6-minute periods with teams alternating ends each period. A period begins with each team swimming off, from the pool ends, for a ball dropped by the referee at the center-line. Following a goal the ball is put in play as soon as all players are in their half of the pool. There is a 2-minute interval after the 1st and 3rd periods and each overtime period; a 5-minute interval at half-time and before the 1st overtime. If a game is tied at the end of four quarters two 3-minute overtime periods are played; if still tied sudden death periods are played. Each team is allowed three time-outs during regulation — one time-out per overtime.

Athletes and spectators need to be constantly aware of: a) the referee's whistle and hand signals, indicating violations, possession, points scored, ejections, etc.; b) the 35-second shot clock; and c) the 2-, 4- and 7-meter lines. Unlike most sports, the referee may not be challenged and, in fact, may only be spoken to during time-outs or between periods, and only by the coach or team captain.

FOULS are separated into those that result in loss-of-possession only — the opponent gets a free throw (the ball and a reasonable time to pass, pop, or dribble it) — and those that result in an ejection or a penalty shot. NOTE: On a free throw the ball must be touched by a second player before a shot can be taken....UNLESS THE FOUL OCCURS OUTSIDE THE 7-m. line, in which case the free-thrower may take an IMMEDIATE SHOT — defense must treat the shot like any other free throw! (New rule this year.) In general, a defensive foul is not called if calling it would negate an offensive advantage.

Loss-of- possession fouls include: touching the ball with two hands; using the pool bottom or wall to gain an advantage; taking or having a held-ball forced underwater; use of hands on an opponent not holding the ball (also, going for the man instead of the ball); offside (offensive player inside the 2-meter area ahead of or without the ball); pushing-off a defender, or swimming over him. The ball may be put in play at the point-of-foul, <u>OR</u> at any point nearer the center line, by the closest offensive player. Defense 1) must not touch the unattended ball and 2) must be aware that the ball may be shot after the first throw (be alert whenever an offensive player pushes or tosses the ball to the hole player!!!).

Ejections (20 seconds) are assessed for fouling an offensive player from behind, outside the 4-meter area; interference with a free throw; unsportsmanship-like conduct; and illegal entry (an ejected player must re-enter from the ejection area, at the referee's signal, without using the wall or bottom). Brutality (over-aggressive or repeated fouling) will result in suspension for the remainder of the game (with no substitute, i.e., team plays man-down rest of game) The offender is suspended from the following game as well. A player with 3 ejections may not re-enter the game.

A 4-meter/penalty shot (one-on-one vs. the goalie) is awarded when a shooter facing the goal is fouled from behind while inside the 4-m line, or if a shot is illegally prevented (off-the-bottom, 2-hands, goalie taking the ball under...). NOTE: The coach may select any player to take the penalty shot.

Secondly, we need to be as focused as possible on developing new teams, training new players and coaches and promoting our referees to a level that allows our players and coaches to grow so eventually we will be the program that everyone else will attempt to duplicate. If our goal is anything except this, we will fail those who have put their trust and faith in our program.

With this said, I want to thank all those who have made the difference for us this year. Many volunteers were involved in making this years championship a success. Perry Korbakis served as our Assignment Chairman and did an outstanding job during the course of the year. Our Executive Committee consisted of Rich Norman(Vice Chairman), Russell Curry(Treasurer) and Jack Wagner(Secretary). Last, but not least, I would like to recognize Jeff Wimer who worked tirelessly to put together a quality Ad Book. Thank you, one and all, for all your efforts in making our organization the best.

Special thanks are also extended to Tom Musch, Tom Nystrom and Marty Gibson who extended the use of their facilities for the all important Qualifying Tournament along with Rich Balcerak, Laura Jenkins and Amy Birtman who worked hard to make both York and Lake Forest our host sites for the State Championships.

A final thank you goes to all the parents who make this league happen. It is because of you that these players are here today. I hope I get the opportunity to meet each of you this week, but if I don't, please allow this to be my humble thanks to you for all the work you do. Sit back and enjoy this years championship. Again, thank you to all those individuals who made today a reality.
